Linking Classical Chinese Medical Understanding to Thyroid and Adrenal

(2 hours in herb; 2 hours in general; 1 hour biomedicine)

Speaker: John Scott, DOM, L.Ac.

As practitioners of Oriental medicine we are expected to have an understanding of our own traditional medicine and conventional medicine. A growing number of AOM practitioners and other non-conventional medical providers use “bio-identical hormones” and other similar substances to address symptoms relating to symptoms due to perceived problems of the endocrine system. Within our traditional system there are theories and principles that connect to our current understanding of Western physiology and endocrinology. As we examine and explore this understanding more deeply it becomes clear that we have the tools and understanding in our own healing world-view to promote and maintain health in ways that modern medicine has only recently begun to approach. This class focuses on the thyroid and adrenal systems and how to understand and approach imbalances using Chinese herbs and acupuncture.

Speaker Information: John Scott, DOM, L.Ac.

Dr. John Scott is a doctor of Oriental medicine and founder/president of Golden Flower Chinese Herbs Inc. Currently he practices in Albuquerque, New Mexico and has been in private practice since 1982. He continues to combine acupuncture with Chinese herbal medicine in his private practice, has taught many classes in the field, and actively participated in research. He has also participated in NCCAOM Chinese Herb Exam Development process, 1995, awarded “Acupuncturist of The Year” by the American Association of Oriental Medicine 1997. Dr. Scott’s passion for Chinese herbal medicine has led him to promote Oriental medicine both nationally and internationally. He served for 4 years as the professional board member of the New Mexico Board of Acupuncture & Oriental Medicine, and since 2010, has been a member of the United States Delegation for TAG (Technical Advisory Committee) for ISO TC 249, which is an international technical organization committee for standardizing TCM concerns.

Clinical application of Yang Qi in Acupuncture

(4 hours, general)

Speaker: Wei Liu, Ph.D., L.Ac.

Yang Qi is one of the most important factors in daily activities for human beings. For acupuncturists, it is important to understand how to apply Yang Qi clinically in acupuncture. This workshop will offer new perspectives on treatment by discussing in-depth the understandings of Yang Qi, the related acupuncture points, as well as the techniques and types of treatment.

Speaker Information: Wei Liu, Ph.D., L.Ac.

Dr. Wei Liu is a 3rd generation Chinese medical practitioner from Tianjin, China and the founder of the East Wind Acupuncture & Tui-Na Healing Center Inc. While living in China, he refined his skills by studying with a variety of acupuncture and tui-na

masters, including 5 years as an apprentice under internationally well-known Dr. Yulin Lian of TCM. Currently, he resides and practices TCM in the Twin Cities area of Minneapolis and is a professor at Northwestern Health Sciences University. He is also a regular guest professor for the doctoral program at The Oregon College of Oriental Medicine (OCOM) in Portland, Oregon and has taught many workshops at various schools. Dr. Liu's unique expertise in TCM has made him a highly esteemed practitioner and a coveted teacher and speaker on Chinese medicine from coast to coast.

Acupuncture & Acupressure for Treatment of Peripheral Neuropathy

(2 hours, general)

Speakers: Micheal Spano & Elizabeth Marazita

This seminar will discuss evidence-based use of acupuncture for treatment of chemotherapy-induced peripheral neuropathy in cancer patients, as well as identifying contraindications and safety precautions of acupuncture in a high-risk cancer population. Acupressure for treatment for peripheral neuropathy in other populations will also be discussed.

Speakers: Michael Spano and Elizabeth Marazita

Michael Spano and Elizabeth Marazita attended Bastyr University with overseas study at the Shanghai TCM University and the Chengdu TCM University in oncology and internal medicine and have practiced Chinese Medicine for the last 10 years in Seattle, Washington, East Lansing, Michigan, Geneva, Switzerland and currently in Houston, Texas. They received a Bastyr University venture grant in 2005 to visit 7 Asian countries to do field research on the use of Chinese Medicine and Foot Reflexology for cancer care. They have done integrative postings in Seattle, Washington at Harborview Hospital, the Seattle Cancer and Treatment Center, Highline Hospital and Carolyn Downs. Elizabeth Marazita has worked as clinical faculty for the University of Washington School of Nursing, Bastyr University and Michigan State University College of Nursing as an instructor and consultant for reflexology/qi gong and Chinese Medicine research. Michael Spano was the lead acupuncturist at Henry Ford Center for Integrative Medicine in Novi, Michigan before moving to MD Anderson Cancer Center as acupuncturist in residence for integrative cancer care Spring 2013.

Clinic Application of Formula Families

(2 hours, herb)

Speaker: Dave Liu, OMD, Ph.D., L.Ac.

The focus of this course is to provide a firm foundation for the clinical application of the Chinese Herbal Formulations. Dr. Dave Liu has a special method of analyzing and explaining the herbal formulas by grouping them into series. This method has been created by him based on his years of clinical experience and wisdom acquired through his family lineage. Each series has a master formula where the ingredients represent the broad function of the category and are repeated in the subsequent formulas in the series. He focuses on the common ingredients and through this he explores connections between the various formulas in the series. By exploring similarity and modifications of a master formula this course will provide the participant

foundation to be able to offer prescriptions that are individualized to the patient, after this course participant will quickly and easily find the right formula during practice. Dr. Liu will also talk about understanding formula in the context of the Western Medicine diagnosis and indication.

Danxi School and Infertility

(2.5 hours, herb)

Speaker: Dave Liu, OMD, Ph.D., L.Ac.

In the Yuan Dynasty, Dr. Danxi Zhu established the theory of *Yin is often deficient*. Danxi focuses on nourishing yin and emphasizes the importance of preserving Yin Qi on maintaining human health. Latter generations of physicians' continual use and development of the doctrine contributed to its growing influence; ultimately the Danxi School was formed, a famous institution in Traditional Chinese Medicine history. Human Yin and Jing deficiency can cause infertility such as poor egg quality, scanty or no menstruation, delayed ovulation, premature menopause, and poor response to fertility drugs. Danxi School emphasizes methods of tonifying Yin and Jing to treat these diseases, the successful rate will be much increased. Dr. Liu will introduce how to treat infertility with Danxi School and his experience. Practitioners can apply this knowledge immediately in clinical practice.

Speaker: Dave Liu, OMD, Ph.D., L.Ac.

Prof. Dave Liu, OMD, Ph.D., L.Ac. is a 4th generation Chinese Medicine doctor. Dr. Liu began to learn Chinese medicine from his family and many nourish Yin school masters since 1970, and has since earned medical degrees and fellowships in CM/OM in both China and the United States. Dr. Liu has over 40 years of professional experience, and 30 years of teaching experience. Currently he is a Senior Professor at three Acupuncture schools for both master and doctoral programs in the San Francisco Bay Area, as well as a faculty of American Congress on Acupuncture and CM for MDs. He also is founder of the American heritage base of the Danxi doctrine and leader of Danxi School in USA.

Prof. Liu is a world-renowned educator. He has been invited to speak on many conferences and universities. He has been listed as an honored professional in the national directory of Who's Who in the USA and the World of CM, and received contribution awards from both the US Congress and California State Legislature.

The Ethical Aspects of Professional referral and Patient Communication

Speaker: Marilyn Allen, M.S.

This course includes an update on the Obama Healthcare Act and will discuss what it takes to create a referral base and opening doors of communication to the patients, and your community.

Marilyn Allen is a practice management consultant for the acupuncture profession. Her expertise spans practice building, office management, marketing and profes-

Marilyn serves as the Public Relations and Marketing Director for the American Acupuncture Council; Marilyn has been a contributor to three different Oriental Medicine journals and in 1999 was named as the Editor of *Acupuncture Today*. Currently serving as the representative to the WHO (World Health Organization) for the development of diagnostic codes for the International Classification of Traditional Medicine. Representing Traditional Medicine providers on the Technical Advisory Group for Quality and Safety. A member of the U.S. Delegation to the International Organization for Standardization. Marilyn has been elected to the Chairman's Advisory Council. The organization is working on Public Safety, Quality and Standards for herb and medical devices used in acupuncture offices. During her free time, Marilyn loves to work in her garden and grows various kinds of fruits and numerous flowers. She also enjoys experiencing various types of Traditional Homeopathic treatments for her research and personal health and wellbeing.

中醫美容保健

(4 general hours)

Speaker: 劉蘊 教授

具有2000多年悠久歷史的中醫美容學在我國已有深厚的理論基礎，豐富的經驗和多樣的方法。中醫美容保健以中醫美容學理論為基礎，採用中醫美容療法以達到美容、美體的目的。本課程安排先簡述中醫美容保健的發展史及必要性，然後將介紹中醫美容療法；從損美性疾病，疾病繼發損美性疾病以及肥胖及消瘦等形體不適等損美原因及治療方法作一詳細解說。劉教授將中醫美容特色療法如眼針療法(眼針療法是微針刺系統的一種療法，眼區是微針系統中與十四正經關係最為密切的區域，其中十條正經通過眼區)及電熱針，電熱針臨床治療驗案都將一一介紹。最後將美容保健方法針灸療法、中藥治療、按摩推拿、飲食調理、養生運動、音樂減壓等醫療經驗都會與與會同業一起分享。中醫美容保健在現代美容保健中發揮著極為重要的作用。其實「最好的醫生是你自己，最好的美容師也是你自己」，這是對每個醫生你所服務的患者都是適用的道理。

Speaker: 劉蘊 教授

劉蘊教授任世界針灸學會聯合會副主席、專家委員會副主任、學術工作委員會副主任、針灸標準工作委員會副主任及加州中醫藥大學等數所大學的教授、博士研究生導師。劉蘊教授在兼任中國中醫科學院皮膚科主任期間，打破了1911年辛亥革命後，連年戰爭等使中國美容處於七十餘年空窗期的狀態，八十年代發動同行，舉辦了「中國首屆中醫美

容大會」並被大會選為中醫美容專業委員會常委，同時舉辦了中國國家衛生部授意的「首屆國際中醫美容培訓班」，並擔任唯一主講教授，掀起國內國際中醫美容的熱潮。填補了中醫美容史上停頓了70餘年的空窗，促使中醫美容事業如雨後春筍般發展起來。

中國傳統針刺手法的現代臨床應用

Speaker: 劉偉博士，教授，執照針灸師

本講座，通過對靈樞傳統的九刺，五刺，十二刺的詳細剖解以及這些手法在現代臨床中的操作和應用，說明諸位醫師加深對其瞭解和認識，迅速提高各種疾病的臨床治療療效。本講座通過大量的現場演示，讓您最直觀的瞭解和掌握這些實用的臨床技術，今天學，明天用，立竿見影。

Speaker: 劉偉博士，教授，執照針灸師。

劉偉，明州執照針灸師，中國傳統醫學博士，骨科醫師(中國)，美國西北健康大學東方醫學教授，以及東風針灸和推拿治療中心創始人。

劉偉畢業於中國天津中醫藥大學，為中國工程院院士，中醫專家張伯禮教授的博士。曾從師於外祖父在內的多位針灸和推拿大師，有幸拜於國際知名婦科針灸及養生大師廉玉麟門下，侍診5年，盡得真傳。在國內期間，同時為天津第一中心醫院骨科醫師。1997年，劉博士移居美國，現為雙城執業中醫師，並在在西北健康科學大學擔任中醫學院針灸系教授。他還在波特蘭市俄勒岡大學東方醫學（OCOM）博士班自該計畫的第一年起擔任客座教授。同時，多次在太平洋中醫大會，大河中醫大會，及哈佛醫學院舉行中醫講座。劉博士著有高級針灸技術（DVD）及推拿（DVD），以及和師傅廉玉麟合著「臨床常用穴的針刺技術和應用」英文版即將發行。

雙手行針技法臨床運用

(2.5 general hours)

Speaker: 劉大禾教授

雙手行針技法來源於中醫的古老針刺療法，經過國際著名的針技大師黃仲林教授的多年研究和發展，現已創造成為一種醫理高深但操作簡便的嶄新行針技術，並呈現在他的巨著《生物空間醫學》中。黃仲林教授一生中創立了多種針療技術，劉大禾教授跟隨黃仲林大師15年，深得精髓，並運用在臨床上，大大提高了針刺的療效。本次講座劉教授將向大家介紹其中的一種即雙手行針技法的原理，選穴，操作技術和病案報告，並將和大家分享自己多年來的臨床心得體會和發展運用。也將在講座中做示範操作，向同行推廣交流雙手行針技法。

系列方劑的臨床發揮

(2 herb hours)

Speaker: 劉大禾教授

中醫臨床常用方劑有好幾百，不容易準確運用。又因為各位醫師的背景和經驗不同，在治療同一疾病時用方會有不同。而高明的醫師常用一個主方加減來治療多種疾病，漢代的張仲景和元代的朱丹溪就是應用此法的典範。劉大禾醫師在家庭的熏陶下和滋陰派大師們的指導下，很早就開始進行系列方劑的研究和整理，經過多年的應用和發展，選出了18個主方，在這基礎上演變發展成200多個方劑，並出版了手機應用程式。劉大禾教授在講座中將重點介紹丹溪學派的系列方劑和他獨創的邏輯選方方法，使大家能在臨床中迅速而容易找到正確和合適的方劑去治療不同的病症。

Speaker: 劉大禾教授

劉大禾教授是加州執照針灸醫師，中醫博士生導師，四代祖傳中醫。劉醫師很早就跟隨家庭和其他大師開始學習中醫，本科畢業於上海中醫藥大學後，在中國最大的三級甲等中醫醫院之一上海曙光醫院工作。來美後又獲得了中醫臨床醫學博士學位。劉醫師具有40年的醫學經驗，以及30年的教學經驗。目前，他是一位在舊金山灣區三個中醫學校的碩士和博士課程的資深教授，以及美國西醫學中醫班的教師。他也是美國丹溪學說傳承基地的創始人。劉教授是世界著名的中醫教育家，被聘為世界針聯教育委員會副主任，他不但經常被邀請在許多中醫國際會議，中醫學會和中醫大學演講，還被邀請在三藩市加州大學醫學院，斯坦福大學醫學院，西醫網絡教學，美國癌症協會和凱撒醫療集團年會等西醫機構中演講。

閉經

(0.5 biomedicine & 1 herb hours)

Speaker: 溫景榮博士

溫景榮博士從中西醫的角度介紹原發性閉經與繼發性閉經，分析引起閉經的中西醫的常見病因，將西醫原因與中醫病因進行對照。在診斷上，如何分步診斷閉經，確定閉經的病變部位，把西醫的下丘腦-垂體-卵巢-子宮的性腺軸與中醫腎-天癸-沖任-胞宮的生殖軸相聯繫。在辨證論治上對閉經進行中醫辨證論治，同時採用中藥和針灸進行治療。溫景榮博士將提供中醫閉經臨床的研究進展，個人治療閉經心得體會及典型病例分析與同業分享。對於閉經的預防與預後都會詳加說明。

溫景榮博士，天津中醫藥大學針灸學院、實驗針灸學研究中心副教授。2003年中醫婦科學碩士畢業于天津中醫學院，師從夏陽教授，2006針灸推拿學博士畢業于天津中醫藥大學，師從石學敏院士。2003年9-12月在天津醫科大學分子生物學實驗室學習了醫學分子生物學實驗，2004年1-7月在國家生物醫學分析中心進修蛋白質組學技術，完成博士

哮喘

(0.5 biomedicine & 1 herb hours)

Speaker: 馬佐英醫學博士

支氣管哮喘（簡稱哮喘）是呼吸系統的常見病、多發病之一，屬於中醫「哮病」的範疇。從中西醫的角度介紹哮喘、哮病的定義。在本節課裡將分析引起哮喘的病因病機，西醫與中醫病因病機進行對照。西醫的診斷治療，氣道炎症和氣道重塑是哮喘的兩個主要病理學特徵，消除氣道炎症和控制氣道重塑成為防治哮喘的兩個關鍵環節。腎上腺糖皮質激素是目前治療哮喘的最有效的藥物，在國際哮喘治療指南中被推薦使用。在中醫方面則著重於哮喘的中醫辨證分型、治則治法和常用方藥。哮喘的中醫藥臨床研究進展，個人治療哮喘的體會及典型病例分析及哮喘的預防都將詳細討論。

Speaker: 馬佐英醫學博士

馬佐英醫學博士，現任職天津中醫藥大學副教授。1998畢業天津中醫藥大學，中醫內科學碩士，2006，中醫基礎理論博士。為中華中醫藥學會會員。馬佐英醫學博士主要研究方向為中醫治則治法研究，尤其在哮病從肺脾論治機理探析方面作很多研究，論文發表14篇。馬博士參編《津沽中醫名家學術要略·第二輯》（張伯禮主編），現代中醫臨床備要叢書·傷寒金匱溫病經典速覽華夏出版社，傷寒論的方與證，現代中醫臨床備要叢書，方劑學，方劑學發揮，現代中醫臨床備要叢書·方劑學發揮（英文版），現代中醫臨床備要叢書·中藥學（英文版）。主講課程有《中醫基礎理論》、《中醫學基礎》、《中醫藥學概論》、《中基雙語（中英）教學》和《中國傳統文化中的醫學心理學思想》，授課物件包括中醫、針灸、中西醫結合、中藥、製劑、護理、康復、漢語言、心理、社保、行銷等專業的本科生，中西醫結合、西學中碩博士研究生以及留學生。2006年6月承擔國際學院美國短期團《中醫基礎理論》英文講座，2009年6月完成國際學院美國聯合學院及西班牙學員《中醫基礎理論》英文講座，2011年10月參加教育部援外專案，承擔非洲西醫師針灸高級研修班《中醫學基礎》英文講座。
